Recommended best practice is to screen patients prior to each visit where possible.

The 2019-nCoV Respiratory Infection Screener consists of 5 questions

## **PART A: Symptoms**

1.	Do you or anyone in your household have new/worse cough or shortness of breath?	Yes No
2.	Are you feeling feverish, or have you had shakes or chills in the last 24 hours (>38 degrees Celsius)?	Yes No

## PART B: Travel/Contact

3.	Have you traveled in the last 14 days outside of Canada?	Yes No
4.	Have you had close contact with a confirmed or probable case of someone with <b>novel coronavirus</b> (2019-nCoV)?	Yes No
5.	Have you had close contact with a person with acute respiratory illness who has traveled outside of Canada within 14 days prior to their illness onset?	Yes No

## **Positive Screener Result Scenarios:**

Part A = Yes Part B = No	If answered 'Yes' to both questions in Part A but 'No' to all travel/contact questions in part B, proceed with respiratory illness precautions.
Part A = <b>No</b> Part B = <b>Yes</b>	If answered 'No' to one or both of the questions in Part A but 'Yes' to one of the travel/contact questions in part B, notify the Area Lead or Supervisor. Must have voice to voice contact
Part A = Yes Part B = Yes	If answered 'Yes' to both questions in Part A and 'Yes' to one of the travel/contact questions in part B, notify the Area Lead or Supervisor.  Must have voice to voice contact
